The Innovative Library Program or Service Award recognizes and celebrates exceptional creativity and innovation in library programming and services. This award honors individuals, teams, or organizations that have developed and implemented groundbreaking programs or services that significantly enhance the library's ability to serve its community.

Eligibility:

Nominee must:

- Be a library staff member (or group) directly involved in the program or service in a Florida academic, public, school or special library
- Be a creative or innovative program, service or project.
 - Program or Project: must have occurred within the past two years.
 - Service: must have been offered within the past two years.

The nominator must be a current member of the Florida Library Association.

Criteria:

Program or initiative will be evaluated by the following:

- Innovation and creativity
- Community impact
- Sustainability

Questions:

1. Please provide a brief description of the program or service (Character Limit: 400)
2. Discuss how the program or service demonstrates innovation and creativity? (Character Limit: 2,000)
3. Please provide evidence of the benefits the program or service has brought to the library. You may attach testimonials (letters, articles, etc.), statistics, and/or assessments. (Character Limit: 2,000)
4. Please describe how the program, service, or project exhibits long-lasting potential to serve community needs while efficiently utilizing available resources (staff, budget, space, technology)? Also, indicate if it can be replicated or modified for use in other locations without requiring a significant increase in resources? (Character Limit: 2,000)
