Eligibility:

Nominee must:

- Be a current or past professional librarian in a Florida academic, public, school or special library.

The nominator must be a current member of the Florida Library Association.

Criteria:

Nominee's achievements and accomplishments must have:

- Spanned at least two decades
- Advanced the stature of libraries within the State of Florida via such activities as:
 - Risk-taking
 - Innovation
 - Significant Change
 - Been so outstanding that their influence is of lasting importance to librarianship and library service in Florida.
